ECEXA NEWS - Innovations for sustainable development in the Ivory Coast

The environmental cluster ECEXA, together with its supporters, Mr Sandor Habsburg of Lorraine and Her Royal Highness Princess Maria Amor, was invited to participate in the high-level economic mission and the third Business Afterwork, organised by the Embassy of the Ivory Coast in Austria on 9 and 10 April 2025 in Vienna.

This invitation represented an important step in strengthening diplomatic relations and promoting closer cooperation between ECEXA, the Royal Majesty and the international community. The event included a strategy session with ECEXA, during which participants engaged in targeted discussions on investment and strategic partnerships, as well as a session aimed at the general public. This included interactive panels and expert presentations on economic prospects and opportunities for cooperation.

In addition, visits were organized to ECCXA cluster partners to explore the transfer of know-how in strategic sectors such as 'environmental technology and management, and the implementation of renewable energy solutions'
